Categories for Appointment

	Clinical description	Timeframe for Appointment
Category 1 - Urgent	Adult with two or more BSL readings less than 3 or greater than 15 in the last week.  Urgent Ambulatory insulin stabilisation – GP will be asked to complete insulin stabilisation authority form	Within one week
Category 2 - Routine	Non urgent – routine care  Non urgent Conversion to insulin –	Within 4 weeks Clients will be offered interdisciplinary support which may include Diabetes Education, dietetics, podiatry and exercise physiology
Emergency	No emergency services available in community health	Immediate via Emergency Department or contact Frankston hospital diabetes clinics

**Eligibility Criteria**

Clients with Type 1 (ongoing) or Type 2 diabetes Newly diagnosed and ongoing

**Exclusions**

Newly diagnosed Type 1, Children, young adults and GDM
