

## Gestational Diabetes Clinic

- **Multidisciplinary clinic for the management of the pregnant woman with gestational diabetes. Includes an Endocrinologist, Diabetes Educator and Dietitian.**
- **Women diagnosed with GDM will have routine fortnightly visits to this clinic.**

### Categories for Appointment

	Clinical description	Timeframe for Appointment
Category 1 - Urgent	New diagnosis of GDM, pregnant with type 1 or type 2 diabetes or ongoing review of GDM	1-2 weeks
Category 2 - Routine	Post-partum GDM review	8-10 weeks post-partum
Emergency		Immediate via Emergency Department

### Eligibility Criteria

- Pregnant with type 1 or type 2 diabetes
- Gestational Diabetes as per ADIPS guidelines
- Positive OGTT

### Exclusions

Not pregnant with diabetes should be referred to the adult diabetes clinic

(Please note, cannot be processed if minimum information is missing)

- **Referral must be addressed to a named practitioner – Dr Debra Renouf**
- **Referring practitioner name, provider number and signature.**
- **Date of referral.**
- **Patient's name, address, date of birth, Medicare number and phone number.**
- **Clinical details and reason for referral.**
- **Relevant medical history and recent pathology**
- Medications
- Allergies
- Weeks Gestation and EDD
- Results of all recent and relevant investigations
