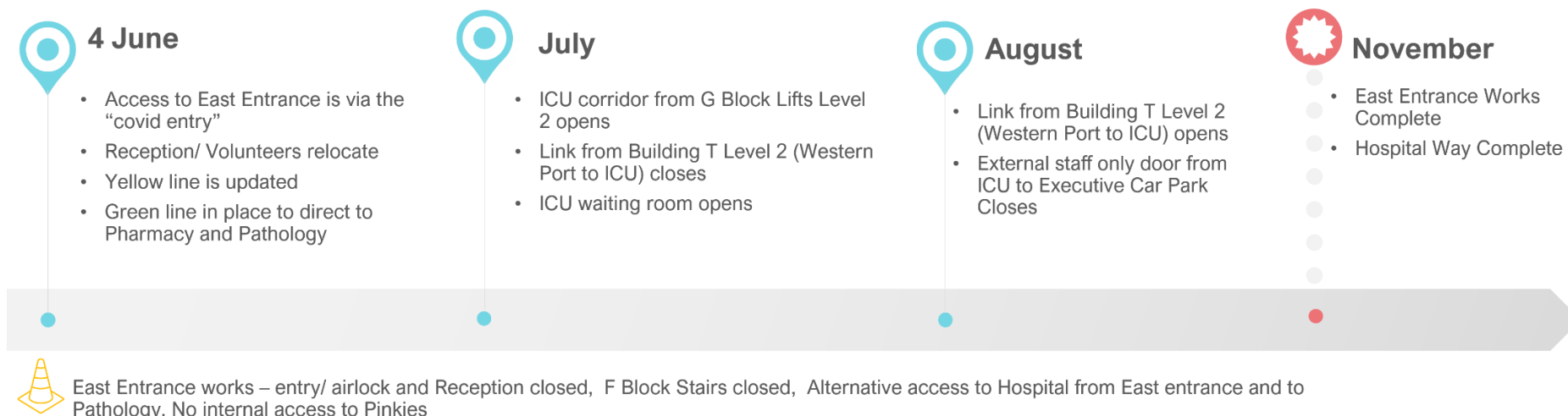


Peninsula University Hospital – Wayfinding Update June 2026

Due to Stage 2 works – the paths of travel to some destinations will change. This reference guide provides detailed instructions for paths of travel from 4 June 2026 and is intended to support our staff in providing clear, consistent directions to our community.

What

Overview of changes at East Entrance with Timeline



From 4 June 2026 -	
East Entrance	Paths of Travel
Construction zone is established at the East Entrance that closes the entrance airlock and doors, internal access to Pinkies Café, Reception area and Building F stairs.	New Entry - The ‘staff only’ entrance will be designated as temporary hospital entrance at the East Entrance (this entry point was previously used during covid). The swipe access on this door will be deactivated during the day and reactivated after hours for staff use. New signage will be installed.
Reception and Volunteers will be relocated to the Information Booth	Yellow Line - The yellow line and signage will be updated to guide people to key locations. Additional floor decals will be in place to direct to Pathology and Pharmacy, Pre-Admissions and Radiology/ Medical Imaging – Outpatients
The existing intercoms at the East Entrance (for Pharmacy and out of hours) are not impacted	Lifts - Both F Block lifts and two G Block lifts are functional

****Please note there is a change to ICU path of travel for visitors from July.**

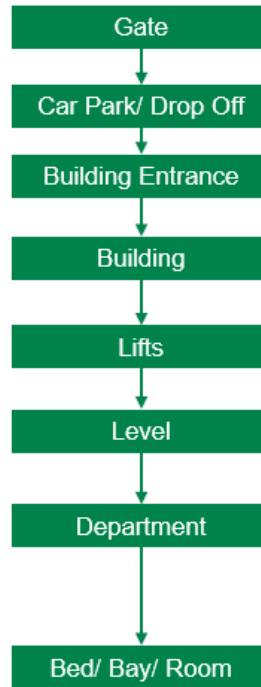

- Gates are numbered 1-6
- Car Parks numbered.
- Building Entrances are named (new Main Entrance, current entrance becomes the East Entrance)
- Buildings are given a letter (Building T is the new tower)
- Lifts are named for the building location, (e.g. Building T Lifts)
- Each level is numbered (Main Entrance of Tower is Level 1 then up to Level 12)
- Departments are named using three elements: Building Letter, Level Number and Department Name. Inpatient units have generic names with Building Letter, Level and Identifier of North or South
- Patient beds, rooms, bays, cots are sequentially numbered
